Collating, Processing, and Disseminating Socio-economic Statistics and Information



- **The SESRIC BASEIND (BASic Social and Economic INDicators) Database**
 - It currently contains data on 237 socio-economic variables under 17 categories for the 57 OIC member countries dating back to 1970. A new category of water related indicators will be added in January 2011.
 - It serves as the primary statistical source for research activities and publications of SESRIC.
 - It is also available online for the benefit of the public in the OIC community or elsewhere in the world.

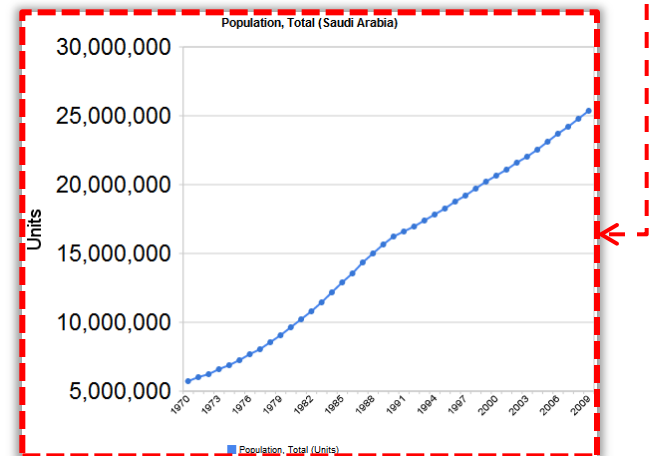

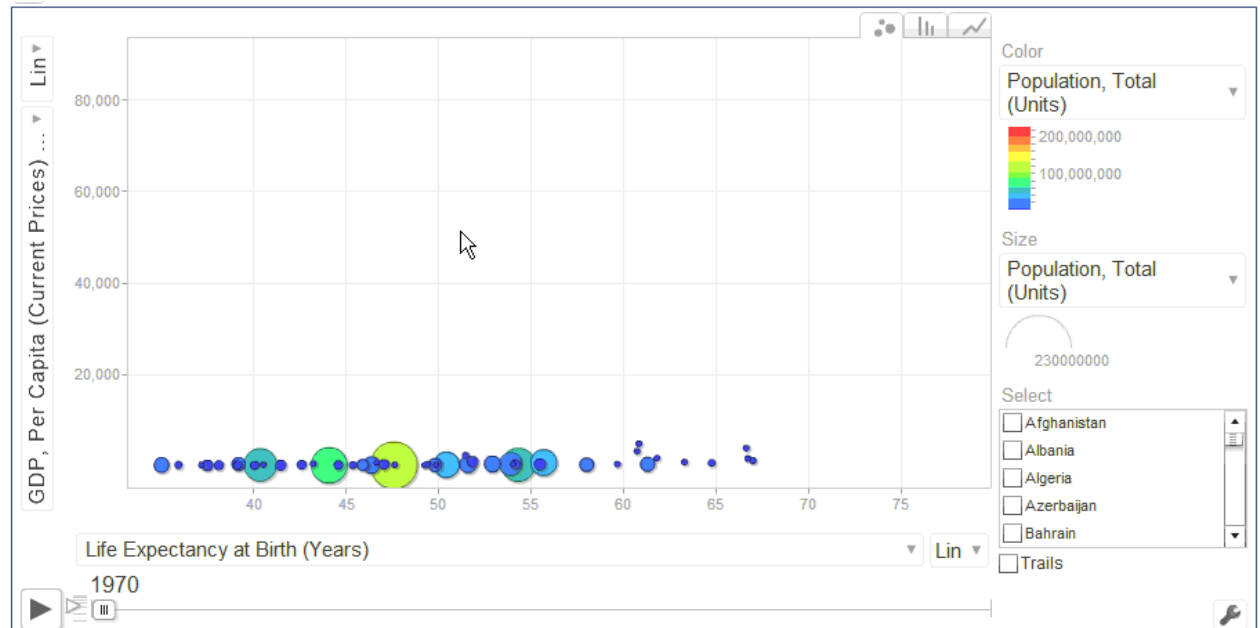




SESRIC Motion Charts (SMC)

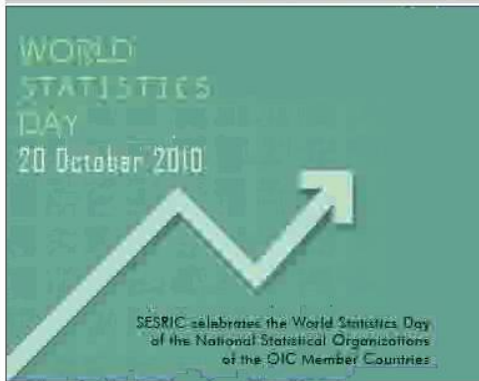

Basic Social and Economic Indicators Database (BASEIND)



The SESRTC BASEIND (Basic Social and Economic INDicators) Database provides data on **237** socio-economic variables under **17** categories for the 57 OIC Member States dating back to 1970. The content of this database is regularly updated and enriched essentially on the basis of information collected from the national statistical sources. The Centre is also in communication with international organizations such as International Monetary Fund, United Nations, World Bank, International Labour Organization, World Health Organization and World Tourism Organization to ensure that the database would be as complete as possible.

SESRTC Motion Chart Generator



SESRTC has been working on to develop an interactive and dynamic motion chart module, called SESRTC Motion Charts (SMC), integrated with the BASEIND Database. The SMC Module allows the users to dynamically explore the trends of several indicators over time, based on statistical data hosted in the BASEIND Database. The charts generated by the SMC Module will be rendered within the user's browser using the Adobe Flash technology. The produced charts will be time series based bubble charts including two indicators from the BASEIND Database, which can be customised by the user to have either linear or logarithmic scale(s) with alternative bubble

Statistical Capacity Building Programme



- The Statistical Capacity Building (StatCaB) Programme for the National Statistical Organizations (NSOs) is a long-term training programme and large scale capacity development project designed, steered, and fully funded by SESRIC.
- It involves collecting information from the NSOs of the OIC member countries, assessing the needs and capacities of the member countries, implementing training programs through short-term courses or workshops, evaluating the outcomes and impacts of the training, and disseminating the activities.
- This program is essentially a twinning program whereby the countries are matched according to their demands and capacities.

Statistical Capacity Building Programme



- StatCaB Programme was initiated in early 2007.
- The first round training courses of 2007 and 2008 were designed based on responses to surveys that were sent to the OIC countries in 2006.
- In 2008, SESRIC implemented the second round of surveys on statistical capacity; responses shaped 2009 and 2010 StatCaB programmes.
- Training courses were given to hundreds of NSO staff from 17 OIC countries in 2007 through 2010.
- At the beginning of 2011, the third round of surveys will be circulated to the NSOs. The responses to be received from them will be a basis for StatCaB 2011/2012 programme.

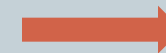

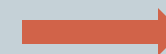

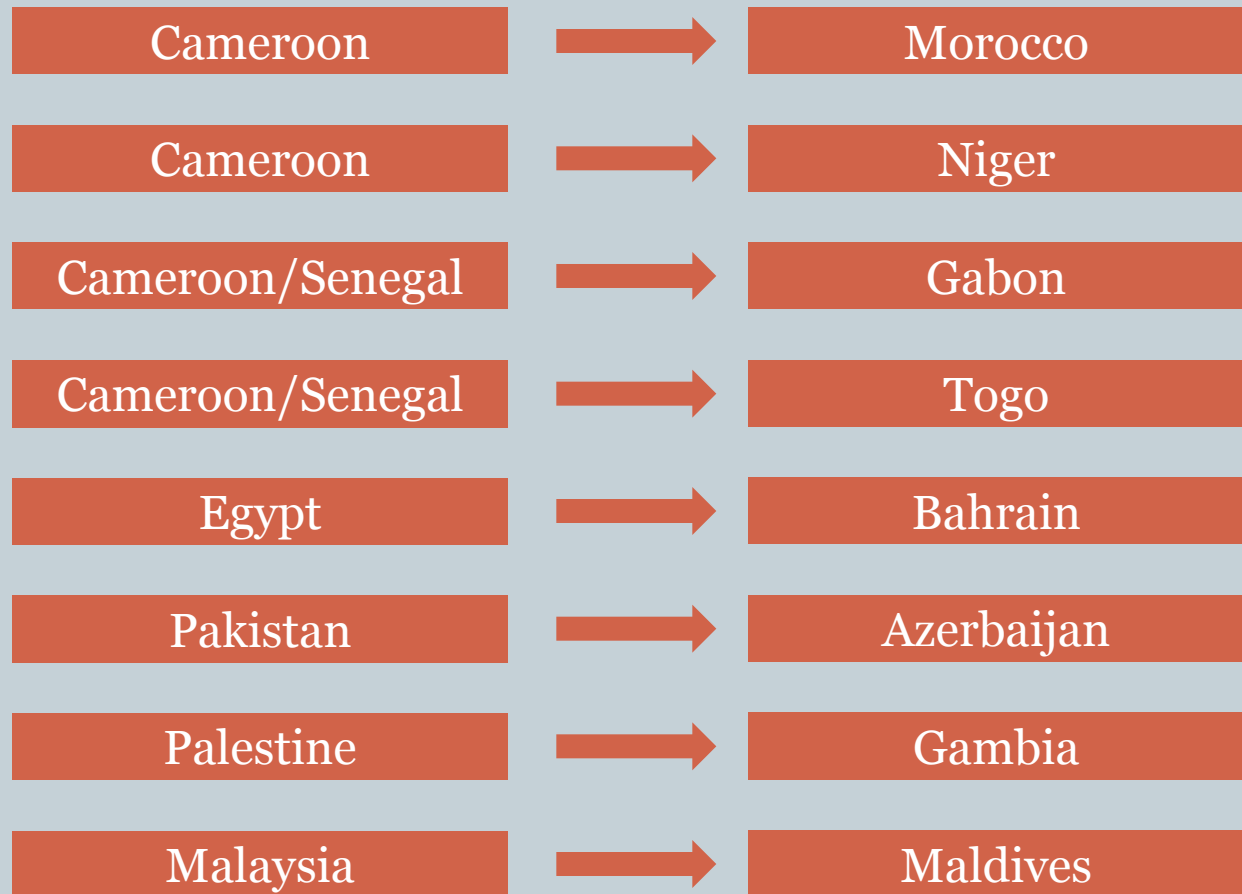

The Statistical Capacity Building (StatCaB) Programme has been initiated in early 2007. Within this framework, the Centre is organising short-term statistical training programmes regarding needs and capacities of the National Statistical Organisations (NSOs) in the member countries of the Organisation of the Islamic Conference (OIC). The Centre analyses these needs and capacities through the responses of the related questionnaires and sends statistics experts among these countries to perform the needed training programmes.

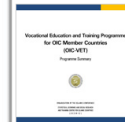
