	The most prominent feature that distinguishes post-2015 development agenda from its predecessors is its focus on	
	robust monitoring and evaluation (M&E) processes at different strata to hold relevant stakeholders accountable	
	for their actions concerning progress. This will, indeed, require a transition from the existing National Statistical	
	Systems (NSS) to modern constructs where the implementation of the post-2015 agenda at the country level is	
	monitored in close orchestration of the National Statistical Offices (NSOs), statistics units of line ministries, and	
	other public and civil entities producing data. This session aims at exploring the capacity levels of OIC member

	and how to close them; and the efficient orchestration mechanisms of the agencies under the NSSs to become
