*“Strategic approach is needed for statistical development”*

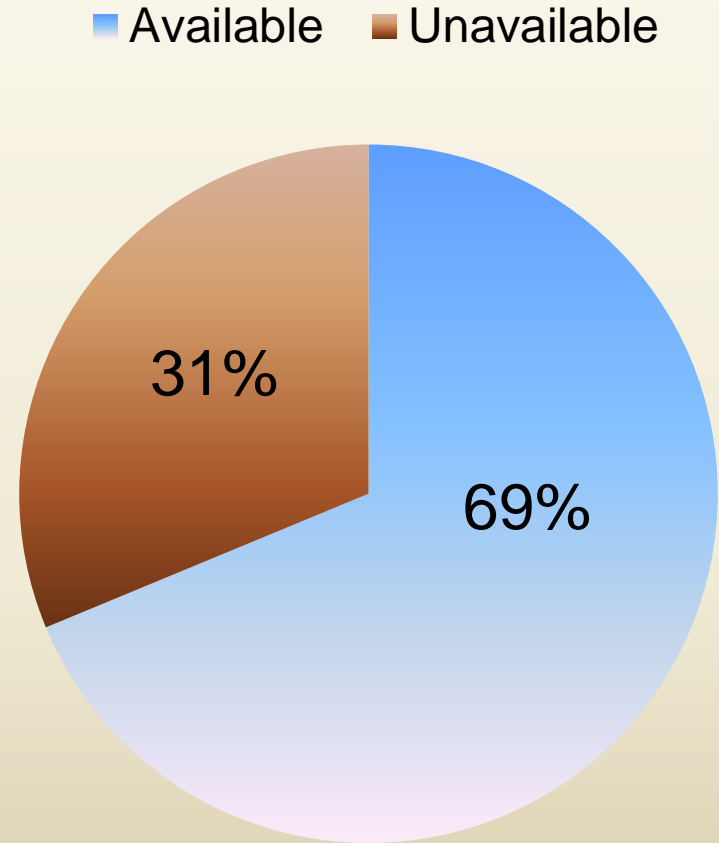
- Current situation on availability of the indicators

- Creating knowledge network
- Nomination of theme coordinators/reporters
- Make information available on websites of NSOs so that all national and international organizations can tap into it

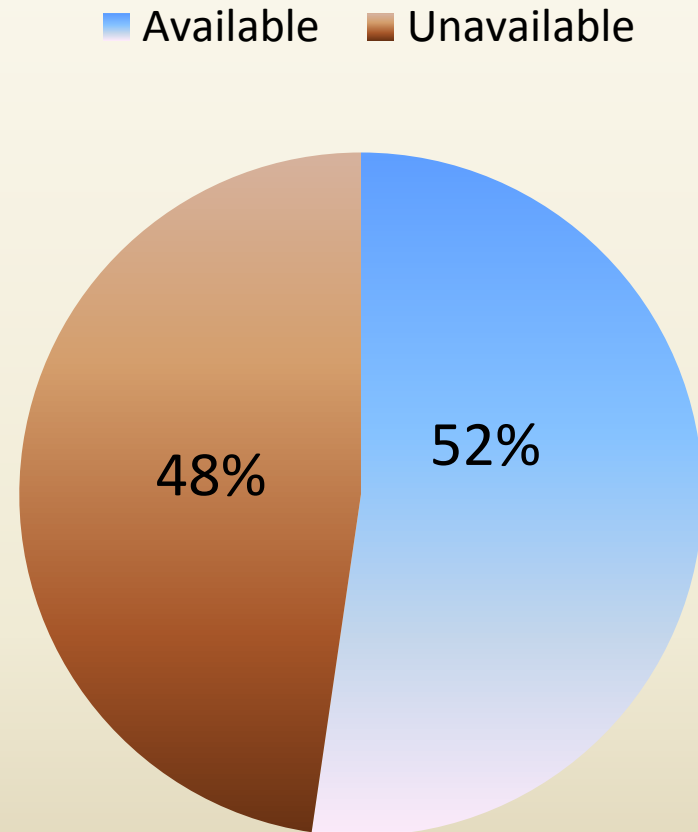
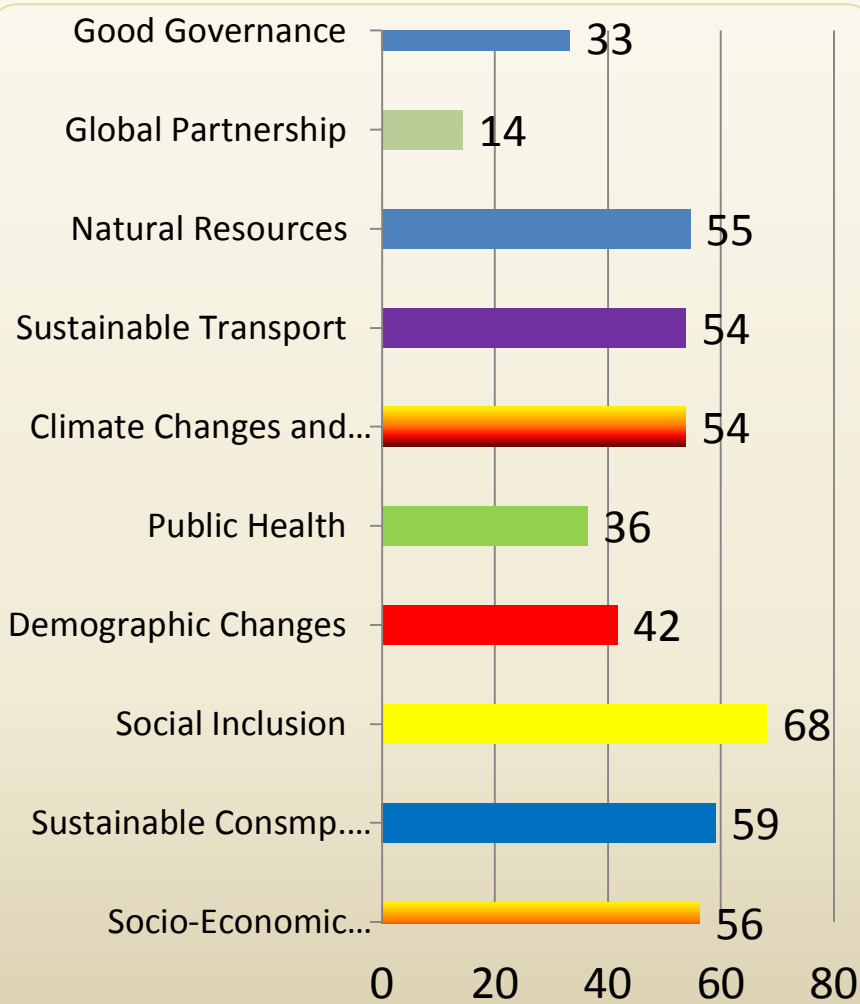

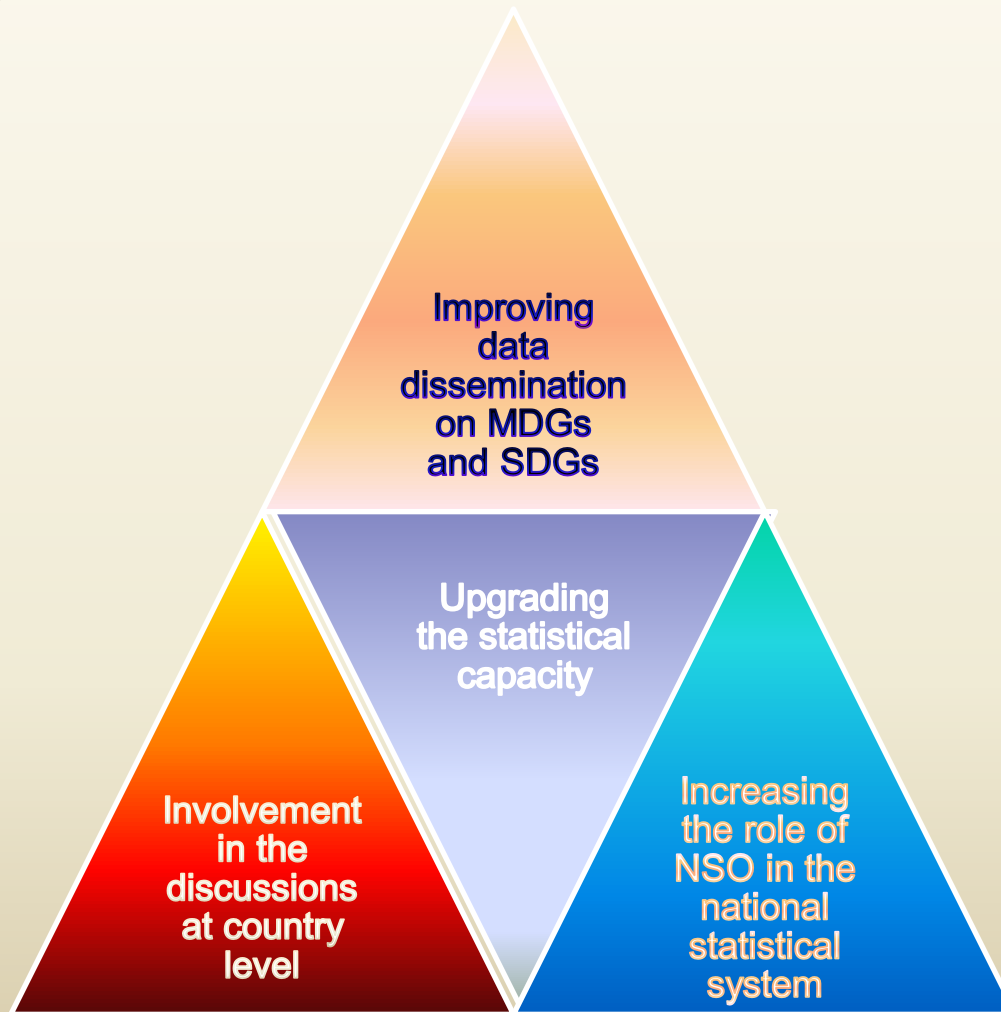
