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Report on the OIC-StatCom Executive Work Plan Activities

OIC-CPS OIC Certification Programme for Statisticians

1 Project Summary

The project basically aims at certifying the expertise and knowledge on the professional conduct of statistical work by official statistics professionals in the OIC Member Countries. The project further aims at recognizing those who have achieved an acceptable level of professional competence in the understanding and application of statistical methods and are bound by code of ethics, principles and good practices of Official Statistics. In the framework of the project, a Certification Advisory Board (CAB) together with an Examination Committee (ExCom) will be established, public relations mechanism to promote the OIC Certification Programme for Statisticians (OIC-CPS) in the OIC Member Countries will be developed, and the Basic Level Certification Exams (CertEx-Basic) will be conducted during this first phase. The Coordination Office (CO) will facilitate the coordination among the OIC-CPS stakeholders. The CAB, composed of the Members of the Bureau of the OIC-StatCom, will appoint the members of the ExCom from the nominations submitted by the competent NSOs and/or the academia representing the geographic and socio-economic regions of the OIC, and international organisations. In parallel, the public relations activities will be developed by the CO to promote and raise the awareness in the OIC-CPS. The final leg of the first phase will involve the conduct of exams and awarding of the certifications to those who successfully pass the exam.

2 Overall Objective

To enhance the quality of human resources in the NSOs of OIC Member Countries and contribute in the capacity development of the NSS of the OIC Member Countries by supporting and certifying bright junior statistical professionals.

3 Project Purpose

To certify the junior statistical professionals working in the NSOs of OIC Member Countries with at least 2 years of experience through the CertEx-Basic.

4 Expected Results

- Awareness about the need of certifying the expertise and knowledge on the professional conduct of official statistical work among the senior level management and staff of NSOs in the OIC Member Countries increased.
- Technical capacity of statistical professionals increased and their achievement recognised.
- Notion of continuous learning in official statistics promoted.
- Commitment by the NSOs and their staff to statistical standards demonstrated.
- Quality in statistical processes ameliorated through OIC-CPS certified statisticians.
- Professionalism in official statistics function enhanced.

5 Target Group

At the outset, the project will focus on the establishment of the ExCom with a maximum of 10 members from a pool of statistics experts and professionals nominated by the competent NSOs and/or the academia representing the geographic and socio-economic regions of the OIC, and international organisations to develop the draft official curricula, structure, timetable, admission criteria, and training materials for the CertEx-Basic, and prepare the pool of questions to be asked to the CertEx-Basic candidates. The CAB will appoint the ExCom members. The public relations activities to promote the OIC-CPS, carried out by the CO, will concentrate both on the senior management and the statistical professionals in the NSOs and all relevant agencies within the National Statistical System (NSS) of the OIC Member Countries. The target group of the CertEx-Basic will be the statistical professionals with at least 2 years of experience working in the NSOs of the OIC Member Countries. The candidates who pass the CertEx-Basic will contribute to enhance the quality of human resources in the NSOs of OIC Member Countries. In general, the project will be one of the channels for the capacity development of the NSS of the OIC Member Countries by recognizing bright junior statistical professionals.

6 Relevance to OIC-StatCom Strategic Vision

In the OIC-StatCom Strategic Vision Document, approved by the OIC-StatCom in 2012 and accessible on http://www.oicstatcom.org/strategic-vision.php, one of the sub-objectives under the Accreditation of Statistical Professionals is to "encourage the certification of expertise and knowledge under an official context for the professional conduct of statistical work of statistical specialists working for the organisations of the OIC Member States". The Challenges section of the OIC-StatCom Strategic Vision clearly underlines, among others, (i) different levels of statistical development among the OIC regions; (ii) lack of human resources with strong technological and sustainable management skills, and (iii) difficulties in

assuring data quality. In this regard, this project will contribute to the first phase in the production of a certification system for professional official statisticians working for organisations of the OIC Member States towards a more dynamic system.

7 Contribution to the Multilateral Cooperation among the OIC-StatCom Members

This project will serve to improving the human resources capacity of NSOs in the OIC Member Countries. In the short term, the project aims at certifying the statistical professionals with at least 2 years of experience through passing the CertEx-Basic. In the middle and long term, the project will envisage covering the certification at the Intermediate and Advanced Levels for statistical professionals with at least 3 and 5 years of experience through relevant exams. In the initial phase of the project, an official call will be made to competent NSOs and academia in select OIC Member Countries, and international organisations to nominate candidates for the ExCom which will deal with the technicalities of CertEx-Basic. The project is expected to serve as a catalyst for the statistical capacity development of NSOs through raising quality of statistical professionals in the OIC Member Countries.

8 Composition and Duties of CAB, CO and ExCom

The CAB Members are proposed to be composed of OIC-StatCom Bureau Members and any volunteer OIC Member Countries. Currently, the OIC-StatCom Bureau Members are formed of a Chairman (Saudi Arabia), two Vice-Chairmen (Indonesia and Sudan), a Rapporteur (Senegal), and two permanent ex-officio members, IDB and SESRIC. The OIC-StatCom elects the members of the Bureau, excluding the permanent ex-officio members, for a two-year period considering equitable geographical distribution of the OIC Member Countries.

The duties of the CAB may include:

- Appointing the members of the ExCom;
- Specifying the themes of the certification exams;
- Approving the official curricula, structure, timetable, admission criteria, and training materials of the certification exams; and
- Announcing the candidates who pass the certification exams.

The members of the ExCom, composed of at most 10 experts, are proposed to be appointed by the CAB from the nominations submitted by the competent NSOs and/or the academia representing the geographic and socio-economic regions of the OIC, and international organisations. The ExCom members may serve for a maximum of 5 years.

The duties of the ExCom may include:

- Drafting the official curricula for the certification exam themes specified by the CAB;
- Drafting the structure, timetable, admission criteria, and outlines of training materials of the certification exams;
- Preparing the training materials and questions of the certification exams; and
- Evaluating the exams of the candidates.

The ExCom is proposed to be assisted through the CO, comprised of 2 staff members (1 coordinator, 1 specialist) of the OIC-StatCom Secretariat, to coordinate the OIC-CPS activities, including the promotion activities, between the ExCom and various stakeholders. When asked, the CO will also inform the stakeholders about the progress in the development of the E-Learning Platform to be used for disseminating the short term training materials and conducting the online exams. The CO is proposed to facilitate the coordination among the OIC-CPS stakeholders. In parallel, the public relations activities will be developed by the CO to promote and raise the awareness in the OIC-CPS.
