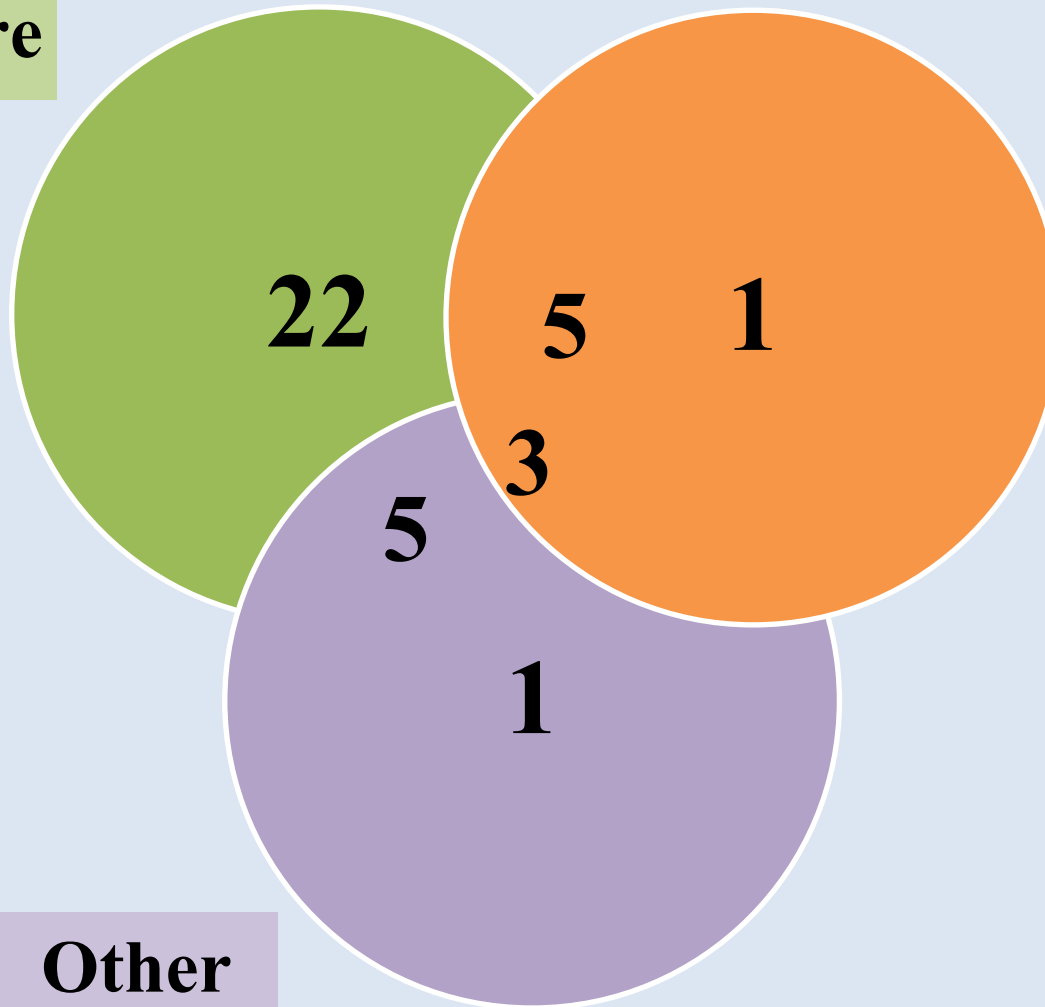

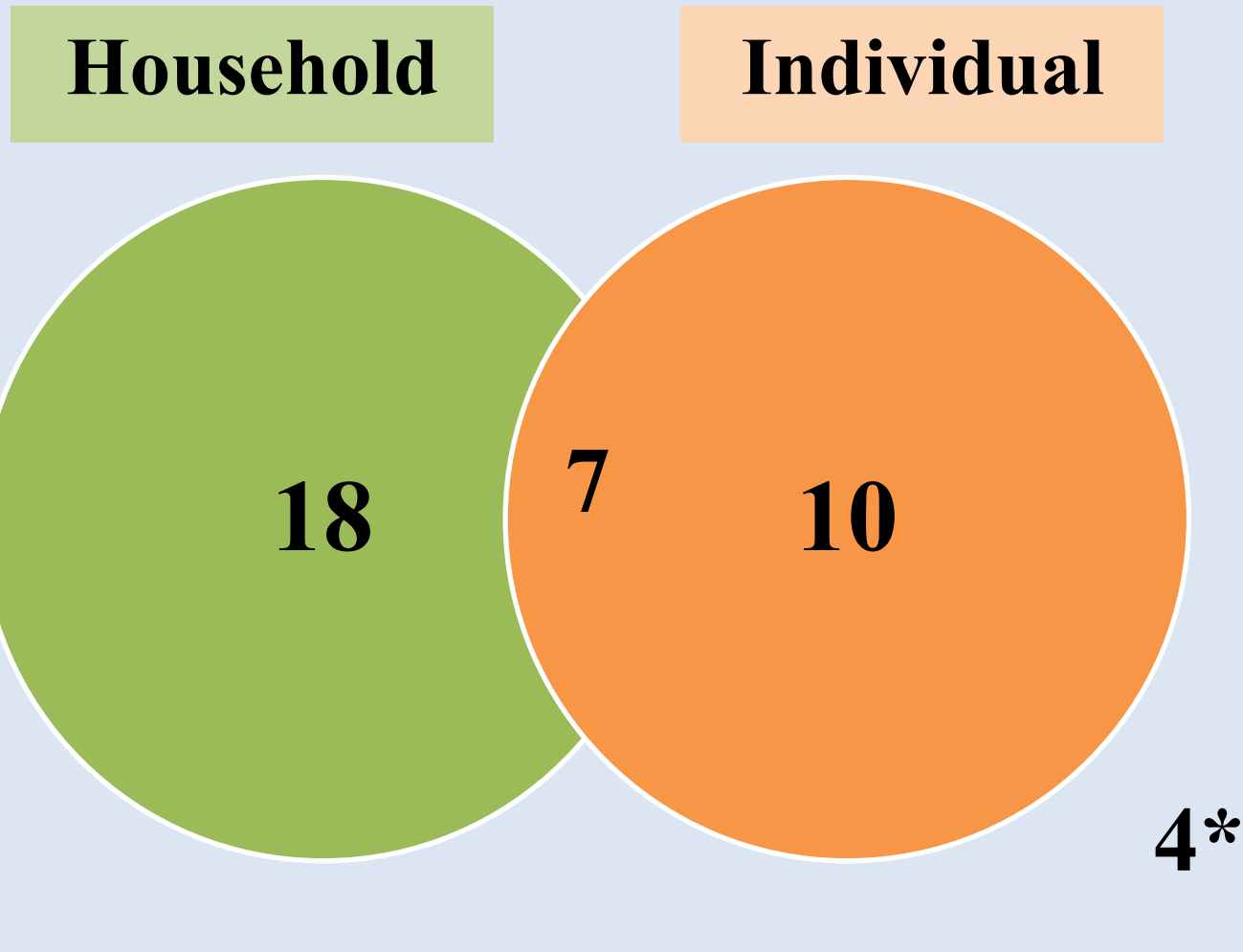

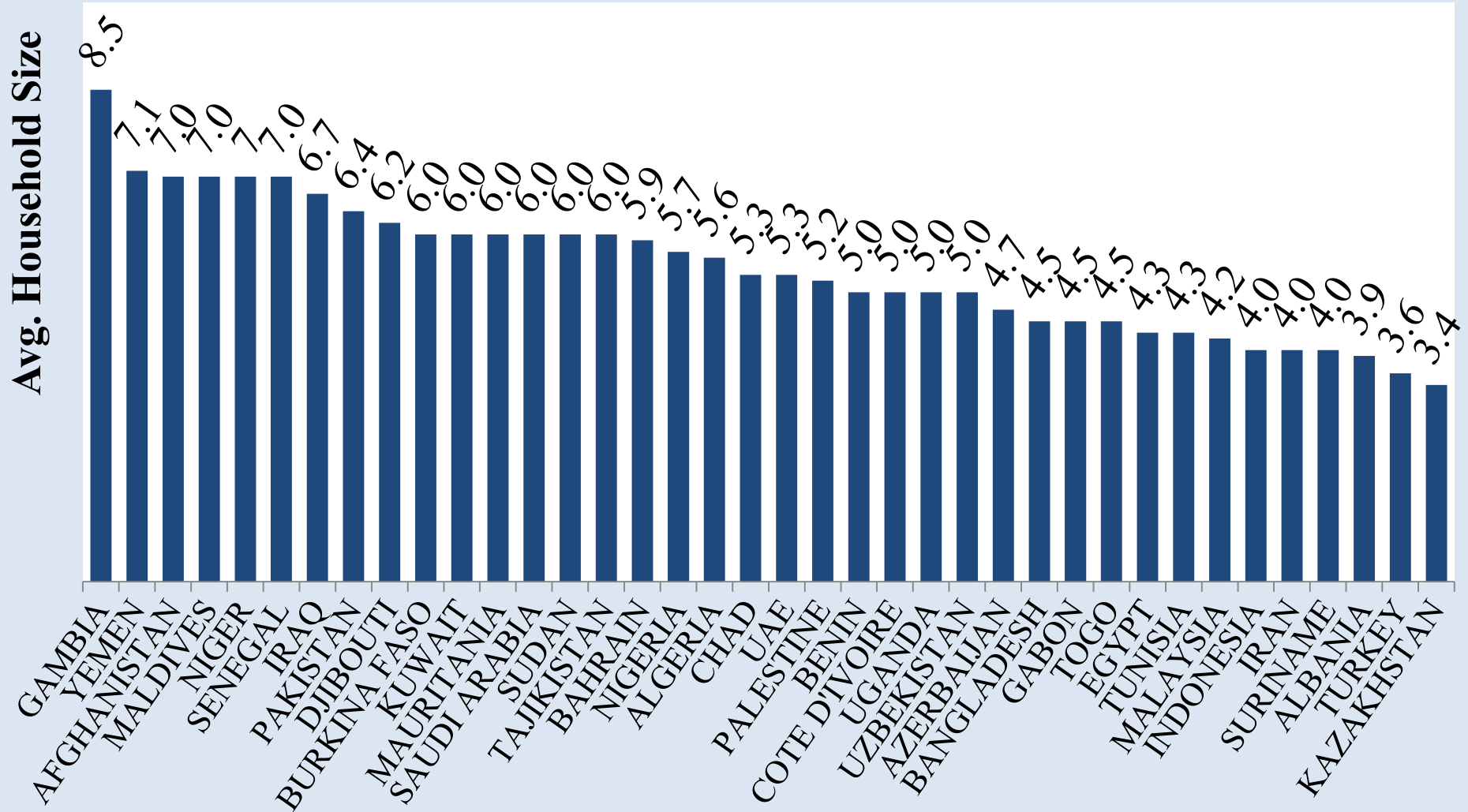

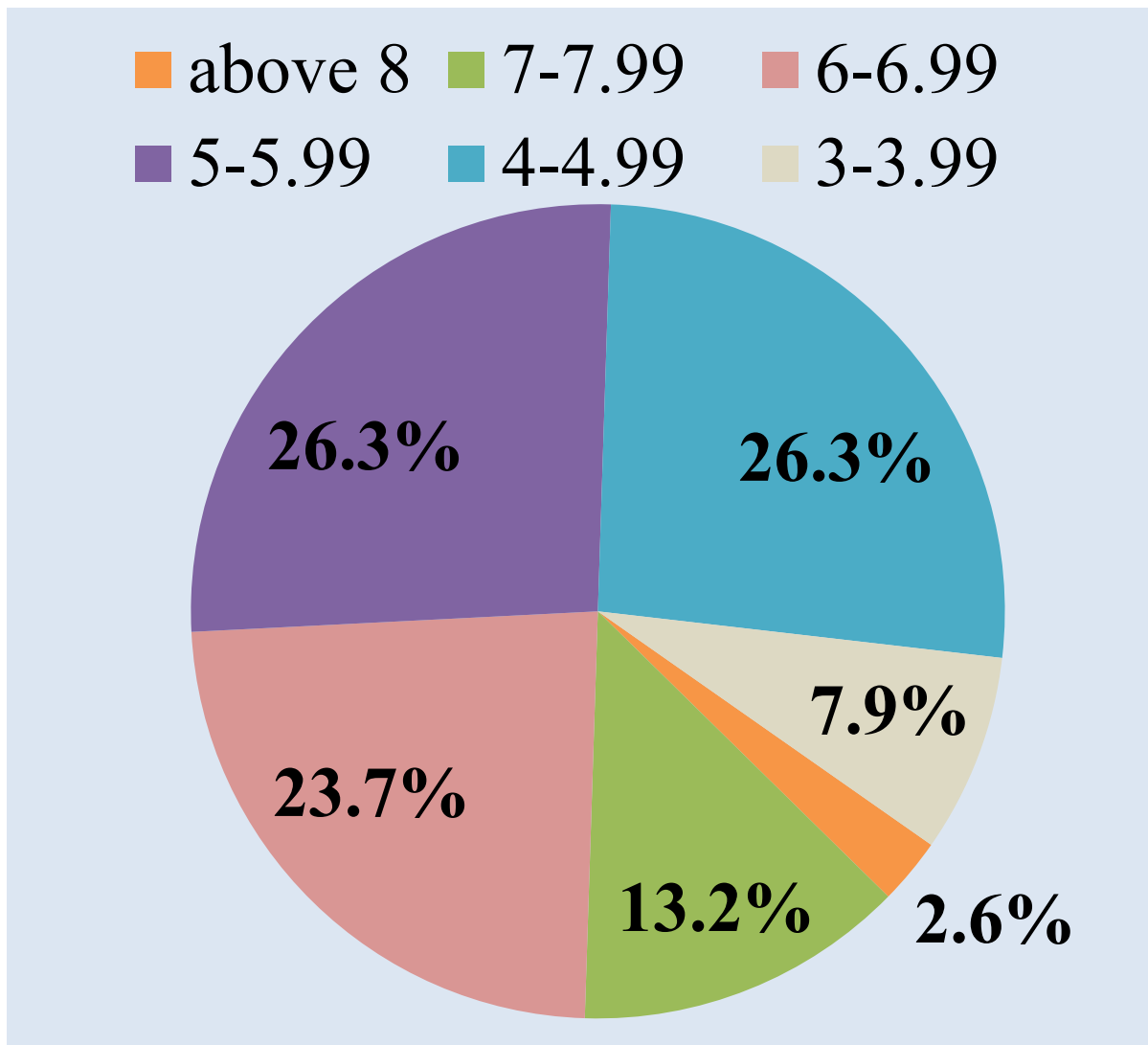

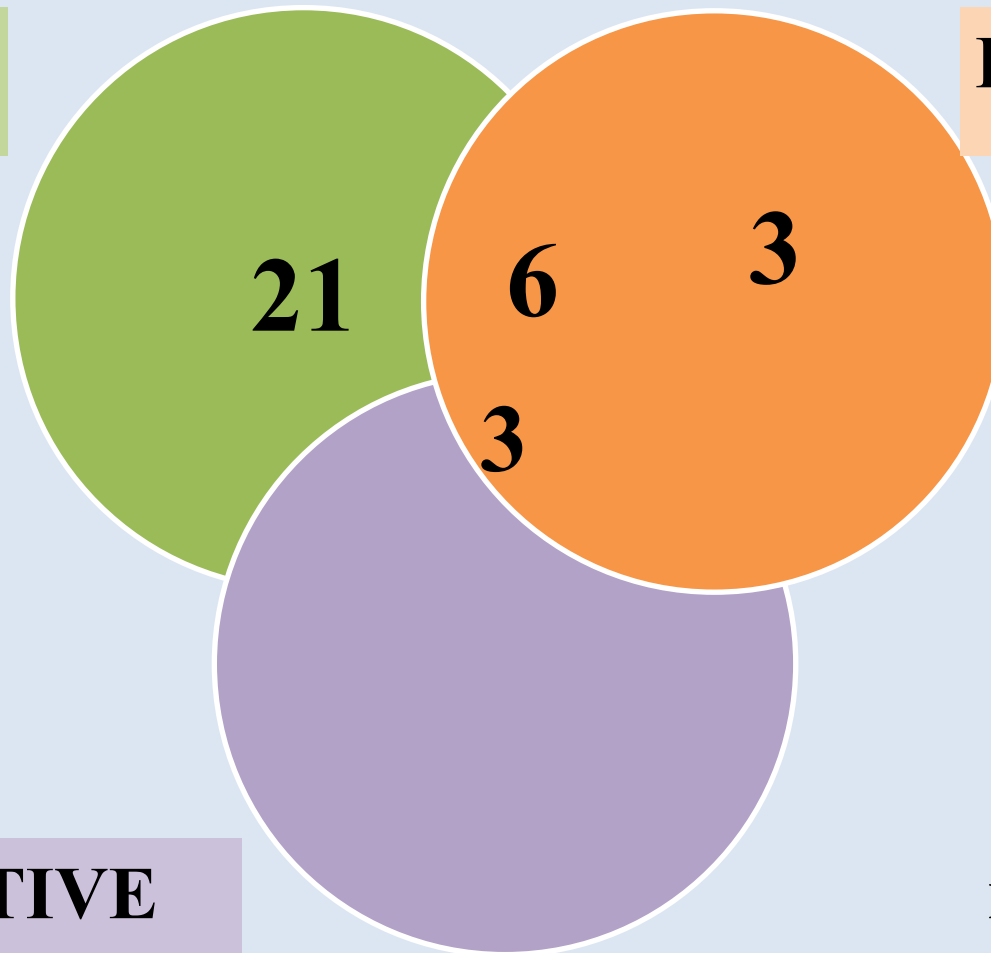

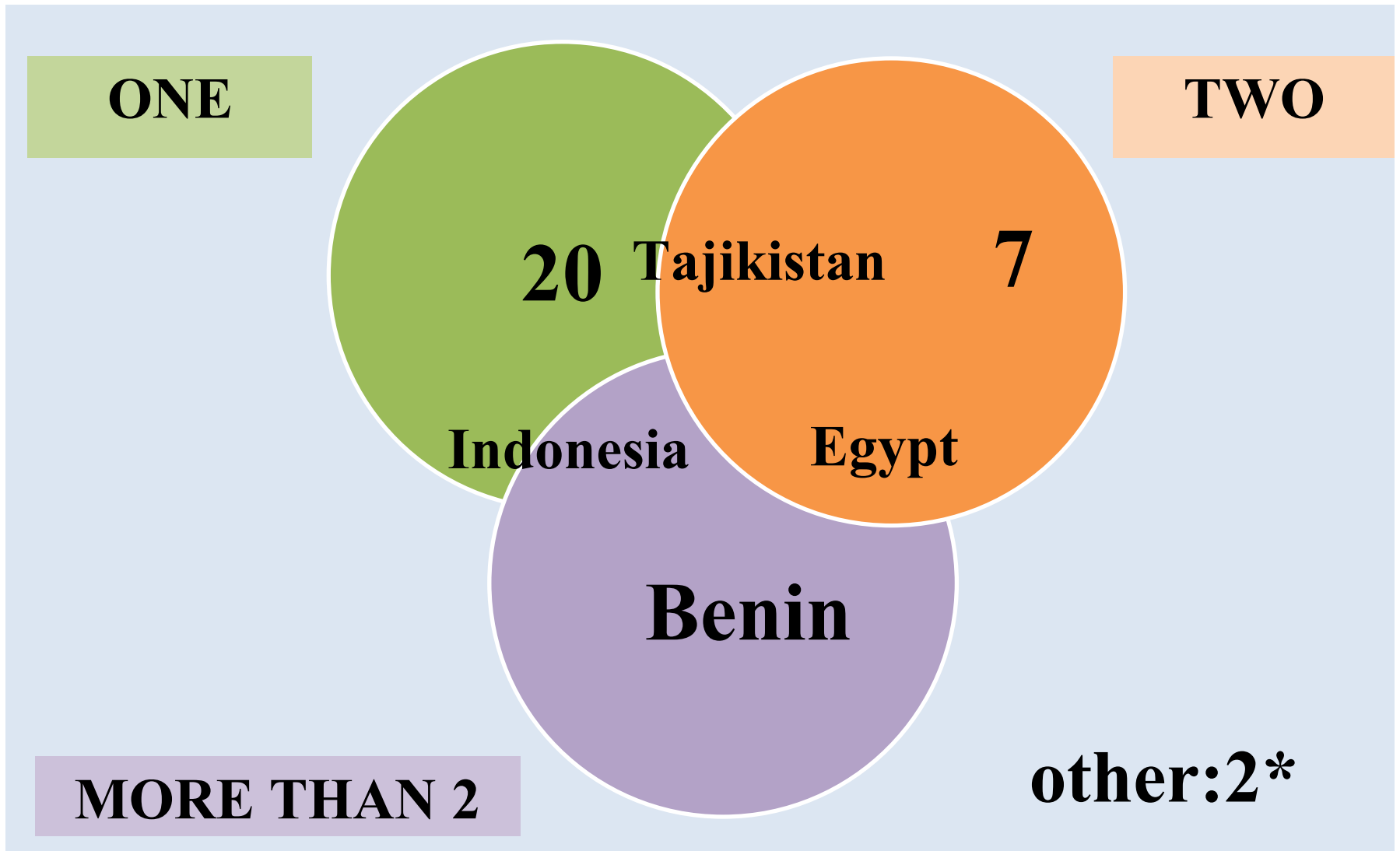

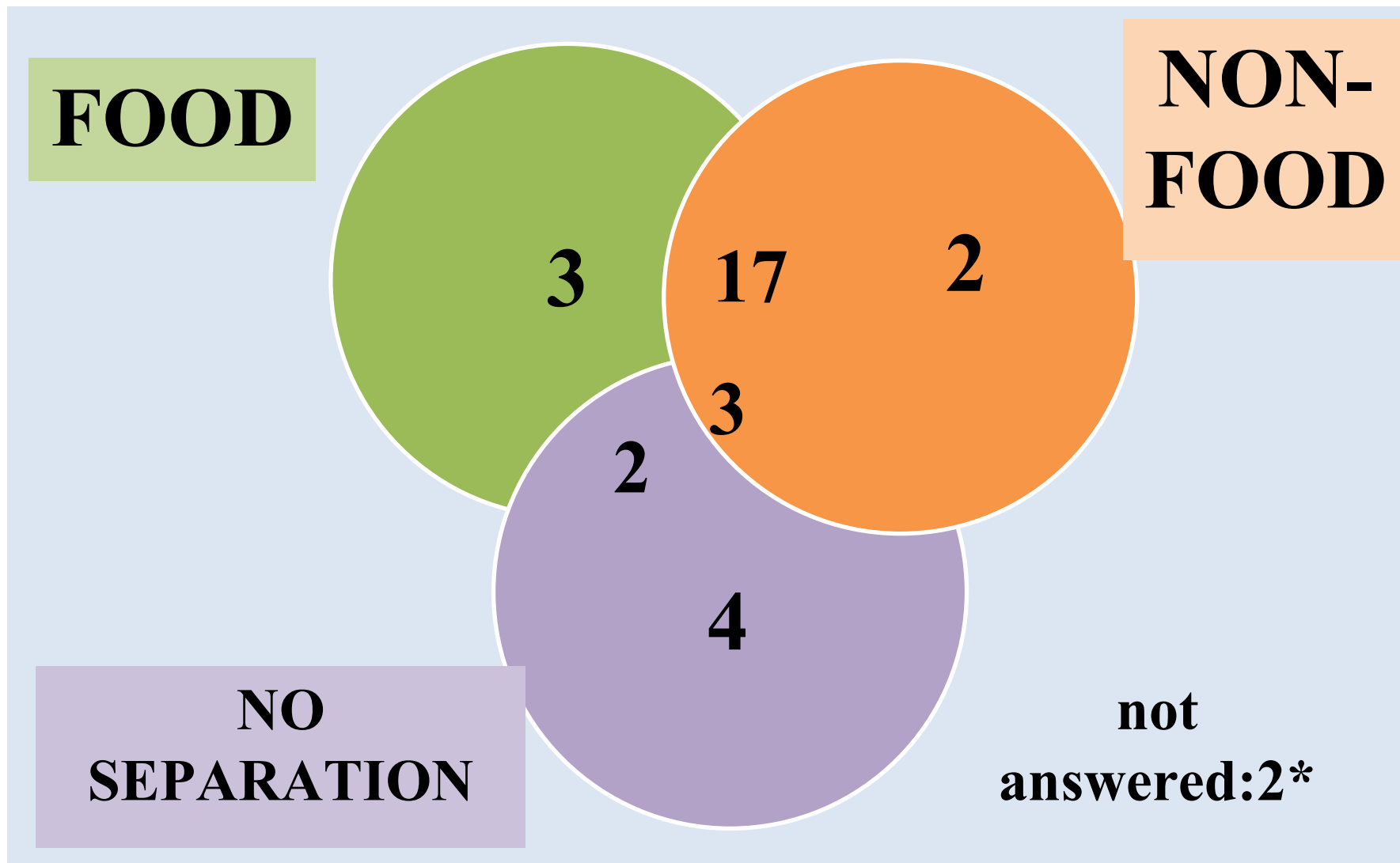

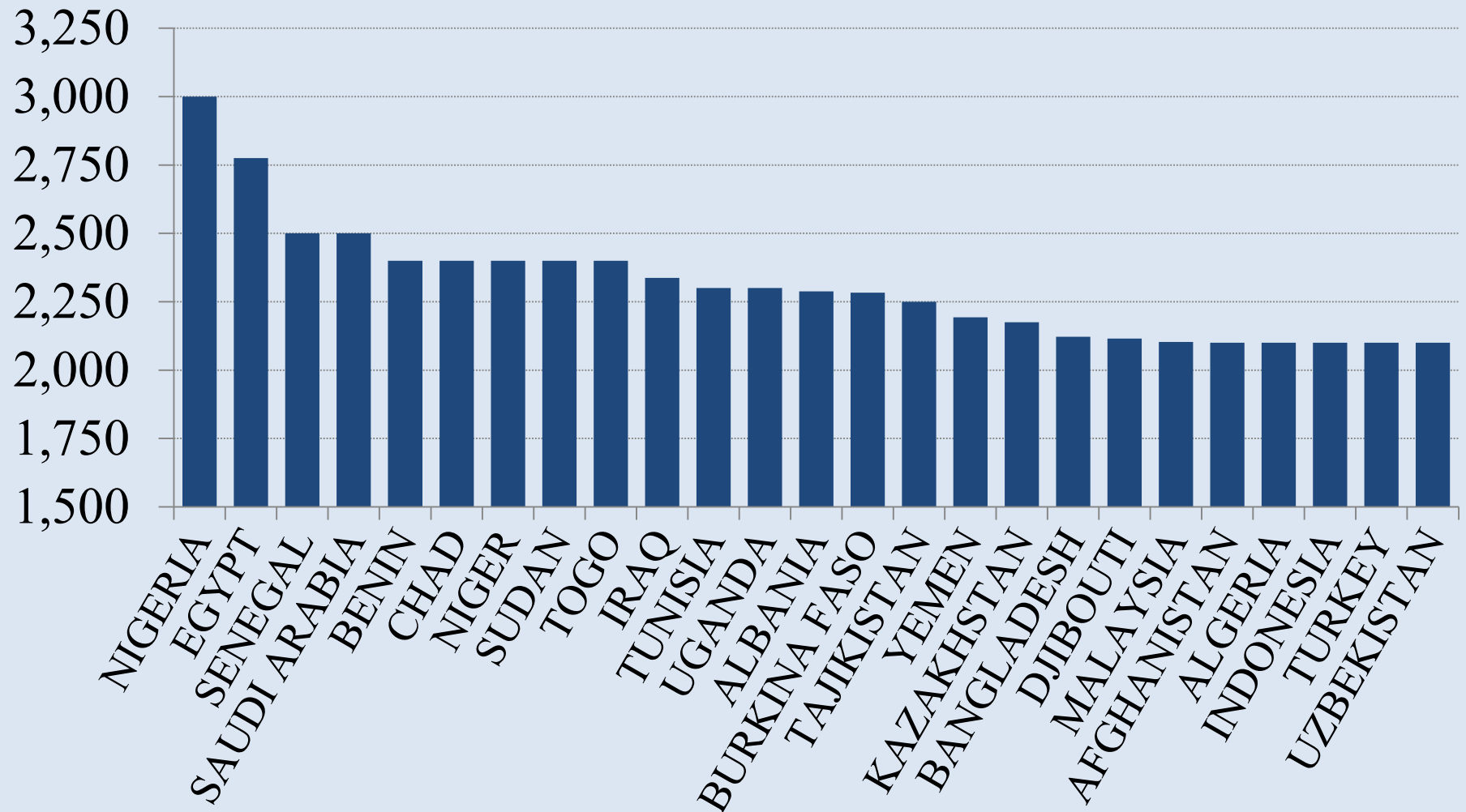
NUMBER OF POVERTY LINES



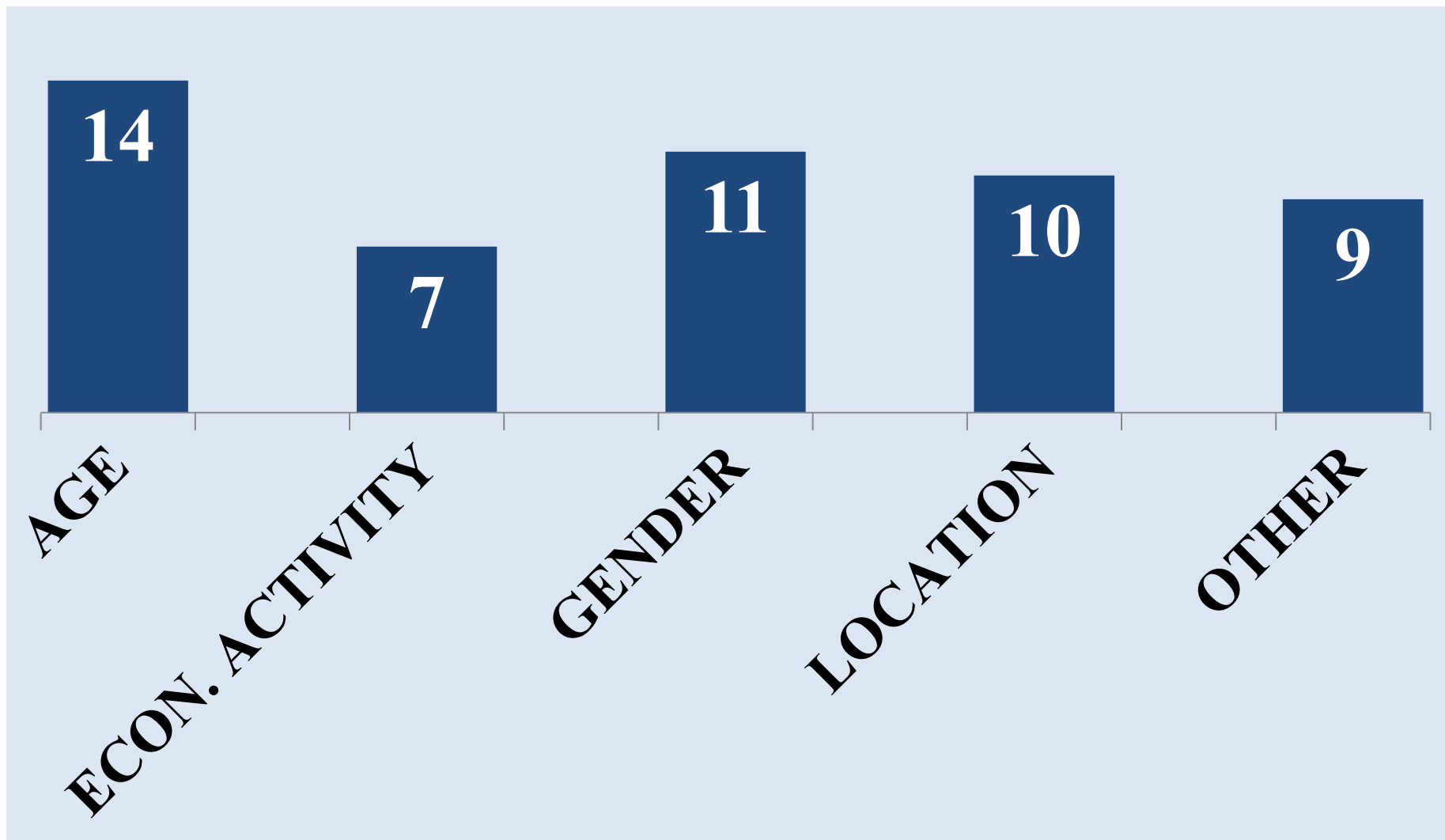
COMPONENTS OF POVERTY LINES



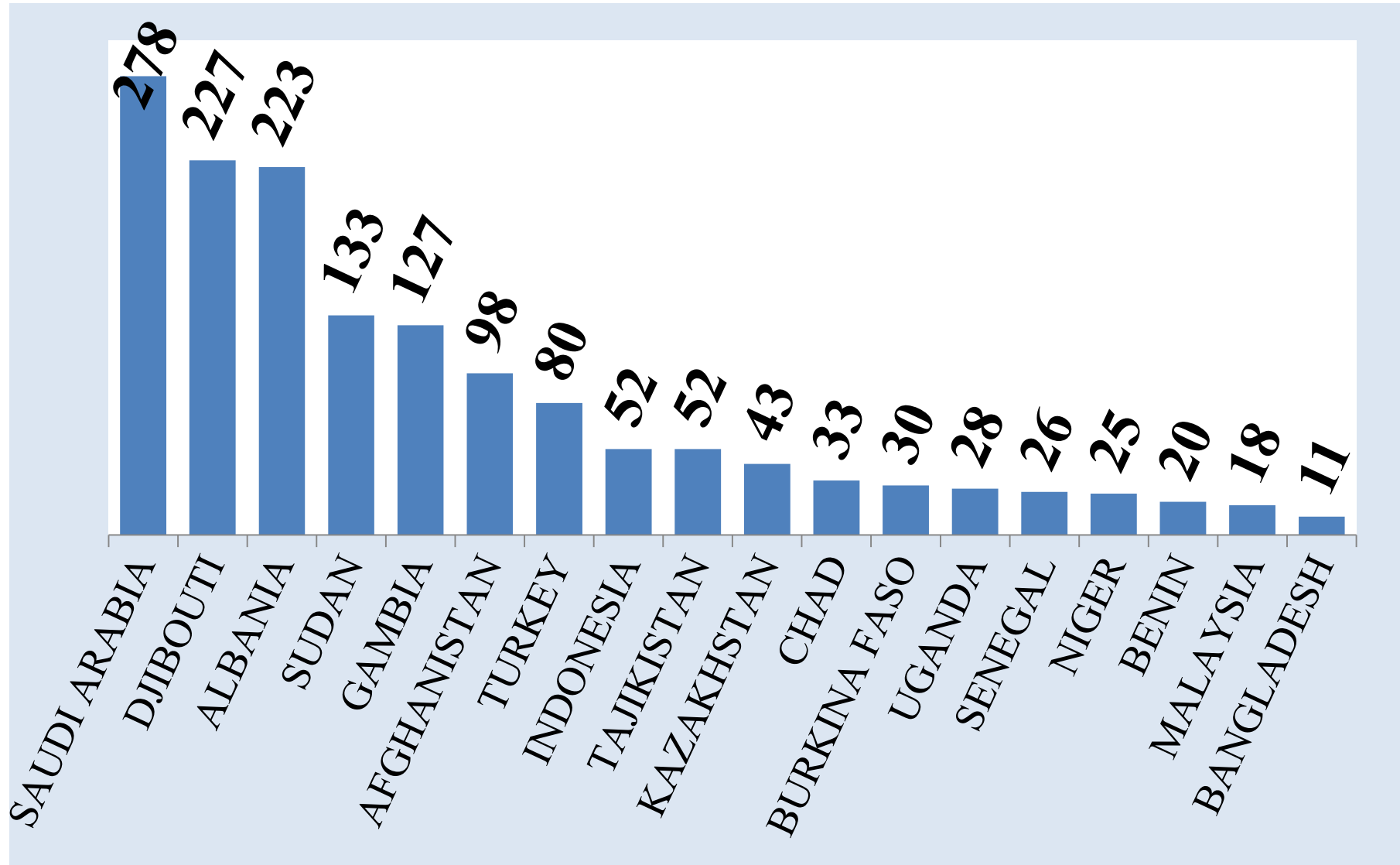
CALORIE THRESHOLDS

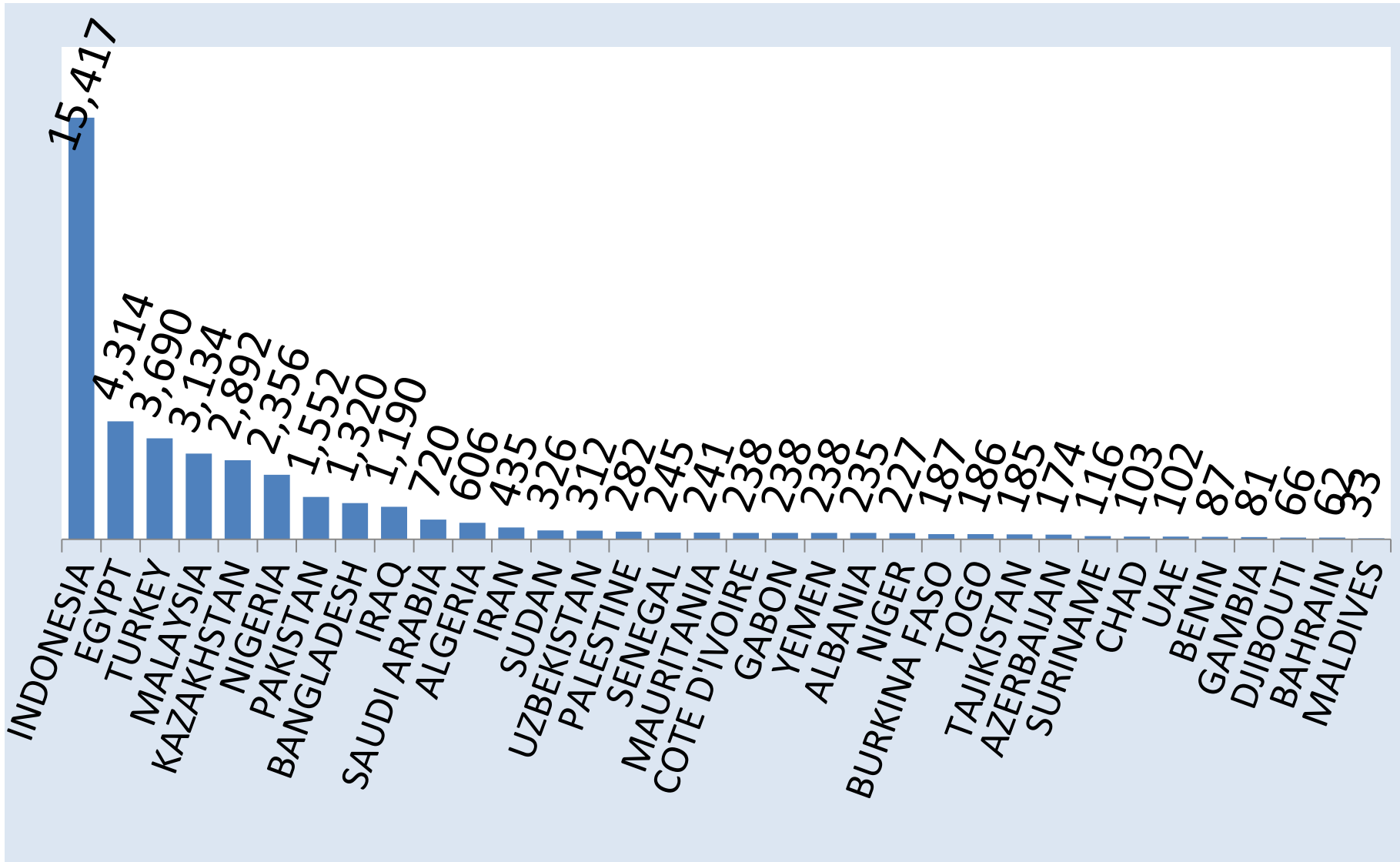

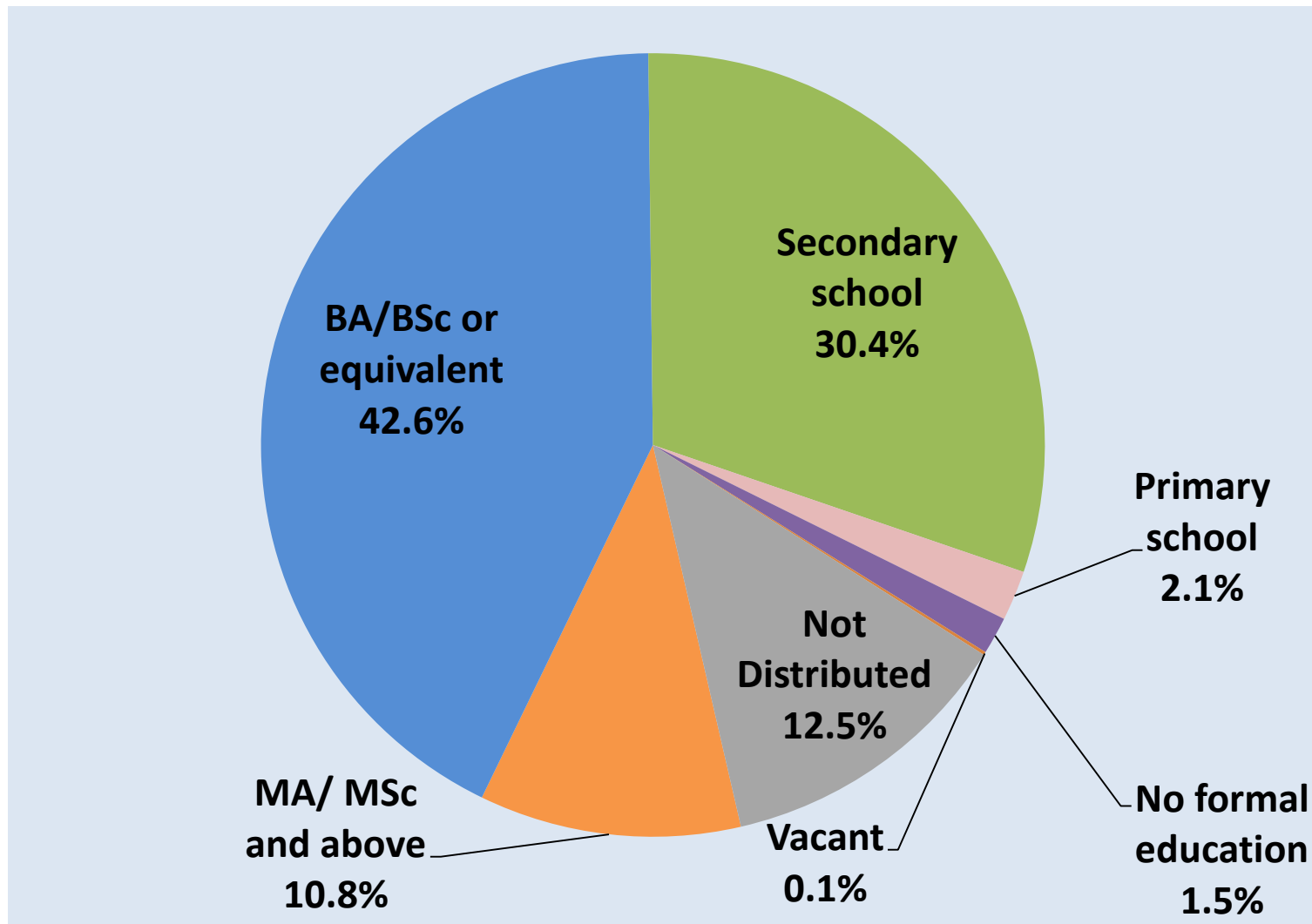
- ❖ 10 OIC Member Countries measuring poverty by multidimensional approach.

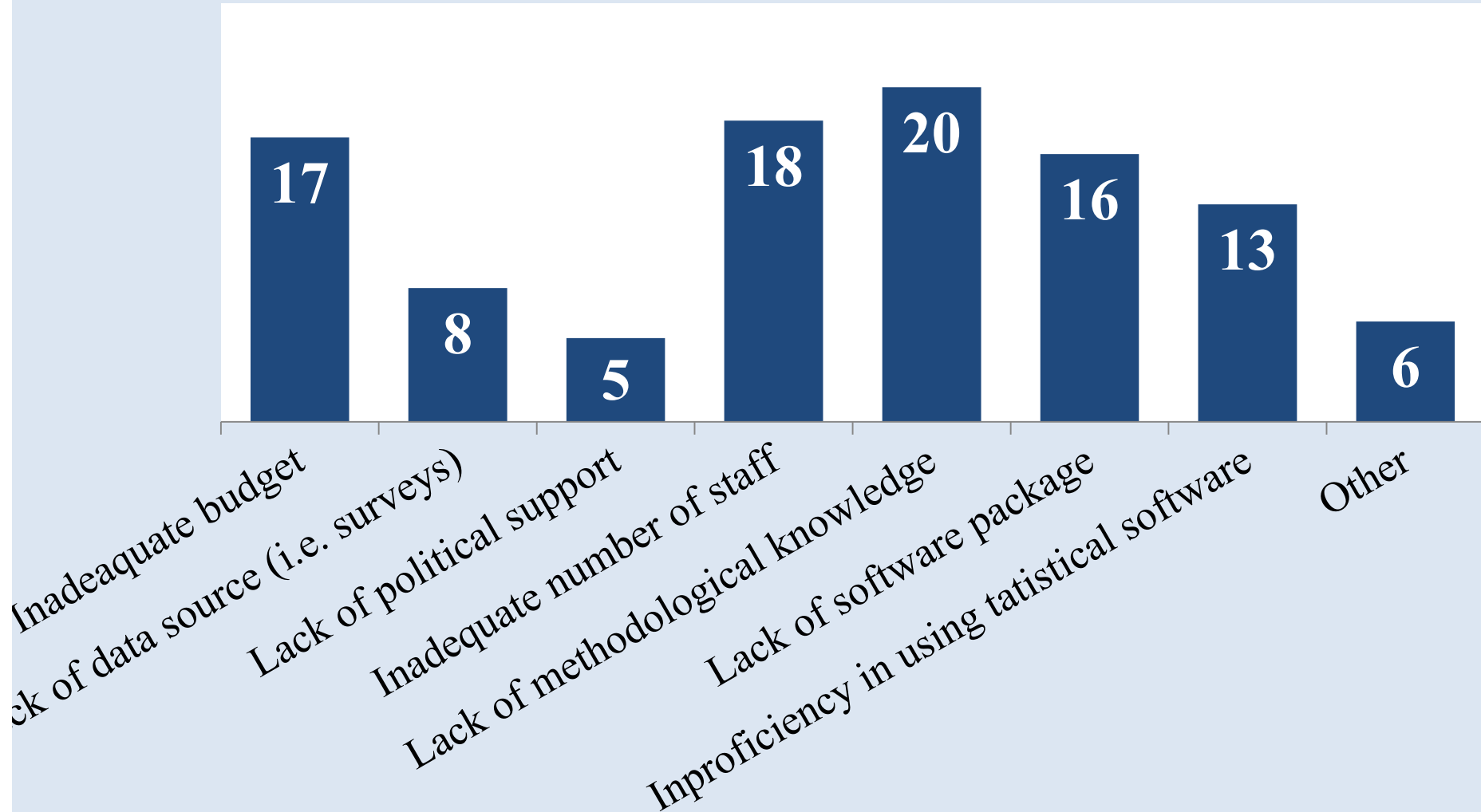
